



NEW STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

UMEI has four scholarships established by donors who believe in the mission of the school and the students it graduates. Scholarships are chosen based on the alignment of the school's mission of faith-infused, whole-person education through learning, service, and leadership.

What to Submit:

- A 250-word essay sharing your thoughts on how you intend to be involved at UMEI and how you see UMEI impacting your current and future goals.
- A letter of reference from an adult (over 18 years of age and not related to you) speaking to their knowledge of you and your character; your involvement in the community; and proficiency in school and/or church/community organizations. *References may be contacted so please include contact information.*
- A completed new student application form.
- A copy of your most recent report card.
****Submit all materials by May 31.****

What is Considered:

- Involvement and proficiency in school and/or church/community organizations
- Reference letter
- New Student Application and personal essay
- Demonstrated financial need
Three of the four criteria above must be met in order to be eligible for a scholarship.

Any scholarships awarded will be credited to the student's account at the beginning of the school year. Recipients will be notified by **June 30**.
