Tuition Assistance

UMEI attempts to make costs affordable to families who are interested. Tuition assistance is available for eligible students. If you are applying or re-applying for tuition assistance, please request a Tuition Assistance form from office@umei.ca or download a copy from the website under https://umei.ca/current-students/. Allocations for tuition assistance are made June 15 and August 15. The deadline for tuition assistance requests for new students **May 31, 2023**.

Family Commitment

In the UMEI mission statement, it states that we strive to make students "doers of the Word" in the community. As a school community, we model and provide opportunities for service as a way of expressing our Christian faith and desire to live like Jesus. As UMEI families, volunteering with the school helps model this value of service and builds community.

UMEI is responsible for 100% of its own funding, which happens through tuition, donors and fundraising events. The true cost of a UMEI education is approximately \$16,923 and the cost to educate a child in the public board is \$14,821. Tuition is kept as low as possible but we need your help.

Meals

One of the fundraising events is Community Fundraising Meals program. Meals are prepared by our caterer and volunteers, and served to guests who pay by donation. These meals happen 4 times per year. UMEI families are expected to work at a minimum of one of these meals per year. By working at Community Fundraising Meals, it creates a savings of \$1,000 per student that does not need to be added to tuition.
